NATIONAL PILGRIMAGE TO WALSINGHAM

This year we shall be going on a day visit for the National Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham on Monday 29 May. Hundreds of pilgrims attend Mass in the abbey grounds at 12 Noon. The sermon, at 2.30 pm, is followed by a procession through the village. The preacher is Father Raniero Cantalamessa, Preacher to the Papal Household. Travel by luxury minicoach, leaving St Silas at 7.30 am and returning at about 9.00 pm. The cost is £10 for adults and £5 for children. Admission to the Abbey Grounds will cost £3.50 for adults, free for children. Children's Activity Tent during Mass - £2 per child.

WALSINGHAM RESIDENTIAL PILGRIMAGE

Our residential pilgrimage is 8-10 August, leaving St Silas at about 10.00 am on the Tuesday morning. The cost will be about £130 + transport. A deposit of £30 per person must be paid by 30 April, as we need to send deposits to the Accommodation Office.

MUSIC AT MASS

Before Mass today there is happy eighteenth century English music by Henry Heron, organist of St Magnus the Martyr by London Bridge, William Walond, organist of Chichester Cathedral, and Thomas Arne, who wrote organ concertos for the Vauxhall, Ranelagh and Marylebone pleasure gardens. After Mass there is a fanfare written by Kenneth Leighton in 1967. He was a choirboy at Wakefield Cathedral and became professor of music at Edinburgh University. Churchwardens must be nominated in advance of the meeting. The meeting will also receive the Annual Report and Annual Accounts for 2016.
