MUSIC AT MASS

The gentle organ music before Mass is by Louis Vierne, who was organist of Notre Dame in Paris at the start of the twentieth century. The piece after Mass is by his teacher Cesar Franck, who was organist of Sainte-Clotilde in Paris. Vierne said Franck showed a constant concern for the dignity of his art, for the nobility of his mission, and for the fervent sincerity of his sermon in sound. Joyous or melancholy, solemn or mystic, powerful or ethereal: Franck was all those at Sainte-Clotilde. **Martin**
