### FRIDAY COFFEE & CRAFT

This group now meets on Fridays, from 10.00 am to 12 Noon, in the Community Hall. It will be run as an activity organised by the Kings Cross Good Neighbours Scheme. Since they will be funding the crafts and refreshments, it will now be **free** to attend. Do support this initiative and tell friends and neighbours who may be interested. ### NORTH WALL STONEMWORK REPAIRS

The cost of stonework repairs to the outside of the north wall of the church is £44,755 (without VAT, which is refundable). The great news is that we have received a grant of £1,875 from All Churches Trust and Cloudesley have agreed to contribute £35,750. That means we only need to find £7,130 (the PCC will contribute up to £4,500). We are currently waiting to hear whether the Garfield Weston Foundation will provide a grant of about £4,000.

### ASBESTOS REMOVAL

We have received a Faculty for the removal of asbestos from the boiler house, which will be paid for largely by a grant from Cloudesley. The work is due to take place during the week beginning Monday 18 June.
