MUSIC AT MASS

St John the Divine said that the prayers of the saints rise like incense before God, and when Charles Tournemire wrote the organ pieces we have before Mass today, especially for the feast of All Saints in Paris in 1933, I think he must have had that in mind. During Communion, Sara oboe will play a Pavane written two years later by Francis Poulenc, and after Mass we have a piece written over 200 years before that by Nicolas de Grigny, who was organist in Reims, about 100 miles to the east of Paris.
