MUSIC AT MASS

The organ music before Mass is by Dietrich Buxtehude, who was organist and church administrator of St Mary's Lubeck in the late eighteenth century. The first piece is a meditation on a German Pentecost hymn. Our trumpeter today is Dan Taylor and after Mass we have a trumpet tune by Henry Purcell. As a boy Purcell was in the choir of the Chapel Royal, by the age of nine he started composing music, and when he was twenty he became organist of Westminster Abbey. Three years later he got married and became organist of the Chapel Royal as well, but he died in 1695 when he was only thirty-six years old. **Martin**

Cloudesley has agreed to give us a grant of £33,000 towards the cost of stonework and window repairs to the north clerestory (the upper level on the north side of the church). The total for the project is about £52,000 (including VAT). In addition to the Cloudesley grant we shall be able to reclaim the VAT. The amount we now need to raise is about £10,000.
