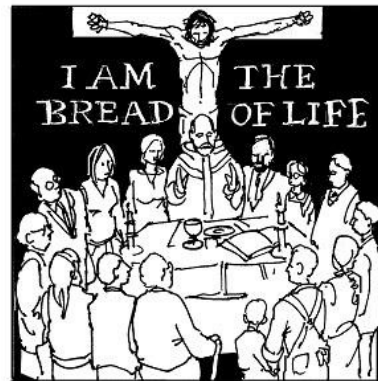

## MUSIC AT MASS

The organ music 10-45-1055 a.m. and after Mass today is by local composers from the eighteenth century. John Battishill was a choirboy at St Paul's Cathedral and grew up to be organist of St Clement, Eastcheap, and Christ Church, Newgate Street. He died in Islington in 1801. Thomas Thorley had his music performed at the Vauxhall Gardens. John Bennett was organist St. Dionis Backchurch, Lime Street for over thirty years. George Berg was organist of St Mary-at-Hill from 1771 to 1775. Samuel Wesley lived from the age of 12 in Marylebone. His father was Charles Wesley, who wrote good hymns. John Wesley the Methodist was his uncle.
